**Matters Arising from Previous Minutes**

The Clerk had not heard from Ed Denne regarding the byway, he will go and take a look at the surface, as yet he has not responded. The request for “No HGV” signs has been refused due to financial restraints.

**Froggies Sign**

Cllr Burge asked whether it so would be possible for signage towards Bodsham to be placed on the existing sign posts. It was agreed that the Clerk would contact Tony Hammock about these. The tourism brown signs are also wanted, these are something that Mr Gross, from Froggies would have to request himself, directly from Highways. Cllr Burge will contact Mr Gross regarding this.

**Salt Bin at Little Pett**

This has been requested by the Clerk and an order has been raised by Highways to have one put on this steep hill.

**Jubilee Celebrations**

The Clerk told the meeting that the beacon at Cold Blow had been agreed and registered as one of the 2012 beacons being lit across the country.

**Planning**

The Council has received an application for roof lights at the Old Dairy, Misling Lane and for a sand school at Dundas Park Farm, both had raised no objection but flood lighting does need to be monitored. No application for stationing a mobile home at Mill Farm has yet been received.

**Any Other Business**

The question of how long from decision the right to appeal was valid was asked. The Clerk will investigate this.

It was noted that there are 2 constraints on the Shepway website regarding the sand school at Dundas Park Farm.
